

Now about the creation of animal and other beings, you will be interested to know that all the beings in the natural world are images of the beings or things of the Spiritual World (not in the physical looks). Like we humans are made in the image of God similarly all animals, insects and all birds, all are made in the image of beings or things in the Spirit World. By the behavior of the animal, the nature of the animal, the form of the animal, so on, you will be able to understand about the spirit being or the things in the Spiritual World whose image they represent. Therefore it is written '*their kind*' (evil spirit being) and '*His kind*' (good spirit beings). For example the unholy tongue is identified as the Komodo dragon, the holy tongue as doves (Read [[replay](#)] - [[The tongue](#)]), bad thoughts to mosquitoes, sexual (physical) attraction to a housefly etc...

Just to summarize in a nut shell the likeness I will take two examples.

When this komodo dragon walks it moves its tail behind it in such a way that it covers its tracks, so that its prey does not know its whereabouts.	Lies When the mouth lies, it tries to cover its tracks so that no one can see it, but fall for it.
Most lizards eat plants but the komodo dragon can eat a pig, deer and even a buffalo.	The root of an unholy tongue is the pleasure of the flesh. It can destroy humans, cities and even nations and yet seem innocent.
The komodo dragon has sharp nails and teeth, but the most dangerous about it, is its bite. It has deadly bacteria in its mouth that makes its bite more dangerous than a snake bite. If it bites its prey and the prey escapes, it will just follow it slowly and wait, for it knows that due to the bite the prey will surely die.	Rumors When mouth speaks rumors its only intension is to destroy and consume its victim. Even a small rumor can slowly and completely destroy a person, it is like murder.
When a komodo dragon's egg hatches, the first thing its babies do is climb trees for safety.	In the beginning the unholy tongue starts with what is known as a white lie, which is socially accepted.
Mosquitoes	<i>Bad thoughts (temptations)</i>
Mosquitoes are very small, common insects but are the number one killer; the maximum numbers of human deaths are related to mosquitoes.	Bad thoughts are part of every day life, but are the greatest cause of destructions of people's spiritual lives.

CHAPTER - 2

Mosquitoes breed in stagnant waters. Even if there is little water mosquito toes breed in great numbers.	Moving waters are compared to repentance and stagnant waters are compared to sin. Bad thoughts breed in a person when a person lives in sin. It does not require a person to be a great sinner to get bad thoughts.
To keep away mosquitoes, the environment needs to be kept clean and stationary water needs to be cleared or covered.	To keep bad thoughts / temptations away, we need to keep our lives holy, we also need to get rid of our sinful lives and cover ourselves with the righteousness of Jesus.
If the background is white, then mosquitoes can be easily detected. But if the background is dark then it is nearly impossible to detect them.	When we live our lives holy then we can easily detect bad thoughts and over come them. But if our lives are sinful then we will never detect any bad thoughts.
To keep safe from mosquitoes we use a mosquito repellent, but this lasts a short time. Most effective is a mosquito net.	To keep bad thoughts away we can try good thoughts but this does not last long. The most effective is the Word of God.
When there is darkness, mosquitoes will come in great numbers, but when there is light they are very few.	When we are sad, angry, depressed, frustrated etc... bad thoughts will come in great numbers. But when we have the joy of the Lord in us, bad thought will be rare.
When we are alert we can sense a mosquito even before it bites.	If we keep spiritual alertness we can sense bad thoughts before they cause damage.
When a mosquito bites it sucks the blood of the person. While it does that, it puts back some unclean blood which it took from other people, which causes disease. Some times it requires many bites to cause weakness or disease to take effect. At other times even one bite can be fatal.	Bad thoughts drain away our spiritual lives. Bad thoughts have most effect on us when we dwell among unholy people. Most of the times it takes many of them to do harm to ours spiritual lives, but at times it requires only one to bring down, or completely destroy us.

There are many more, some of which I would take up in details as the Lord leads.

One thing that you need to remember is that all spirit beings do not have any physical form. They take forms as necessary or as seen by man, for the specific purpose they exist. Generally in the Bible the Spirit beings are referred to as Angels. The word ‘Angel’ means ‘Messenger of God’, this includes Spirit beings as well as natural beings (Human beings). We too become angels when we deliver the message (or do a job) that Lord gave to a specific person or to mankind in general.

Hebrews 2

¹*We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ²For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment,*

Hebrews 13

²*Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.*

In some places in the Bible even Christ is referred to as an Angel of God. The word angel is a very general term and should be carefully understood.

The spirit beings referred to as angels are spirit beings of a specific category. They are a higher spirit being (not the highest- even Satan was not from among them) and are very powerful too (one angel is compared more than thousands of men).

Isaiah 37

³⁶ *Then the angel of the LORD went out and put to death a hundred and eighty-five thousand men in the Assyrian camp. When the people got up the next morning—there were all the dead bodies!*

2 Thessalonians 1

⁵ *All this is evidence that God's judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are suffering. ⁶God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you ⁷and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels.*

They can be compared to the birds of the air (Gen 1:21 ... and every winged fowl after his kind: ...) that can move freely and can watch from great heights. Like there are different types of birds so also there are different kinds of angels.

Many places in the Old Testament, the spirit beings of the Heavenly kingdom have appeared in forms similar to earthly beings, these are but symbolic.

2 Kings 6

¹⁵ *When the servant of the man of God got up and went out early the next morning, an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. "Oh, my lord, what shall we do?" the servant asked.*

¹⁶ *"Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them."*

¹⁷ *And Elisha prayed, "O LORD, open his eyes so he may see." Then the LORD opened the servant's eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.*

Zechariah 6

¹ *I looked up again—and there before me were four chariots coming out from between two mountains—mountains of bronze! ² The first chariot had red horses, the second black, ³ the third white, and the fourth dappled—all of them powerful. ⁴ I asked the angel who was speaking to me, "What are these, my lord?"*

⁵ *The angel answered me, "These are the four spirits of heaven, going out from standing in the presence of the Lord of the whole world. ⁶ The one with the black horses is going toward the north country, the one with the white horses toward the west, and the one with the dappled horses toward the south."*

⁷ *When the powerful horses went out, they were straining to go throughout the earth. And he said, "Go throughout the earth!" So they went throughout the earth.*

Revelation 19

¹¹I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. ¹²His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. ¹³He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God

¹⁴The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean.

¹⁷And I saw an angel standing in the sun, who cried in a loud voice to all the birds flying in midair, "Come, gather together for the great supper of God, ¹⁸so that you may eat the flesh of kings, generals, and mighty men, of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, small and great."

Not only does the animals represent the spirit beings even the earth in its form represents the Heavens.

Many of the teachers and Bible Scholars have given revelations that the Heavens have many levels, this is true.

Like the earth the Heavens is also made of many levels.

Earth levels consist of Underground (the core of the earth is burning fire - lava), Sea, Land (sea level), Valley, Plateau, Mountains and Mountaintops (all together seven levels).

Similarly Heaven too consist of Hades (Hell), Grave, Earth (Earthly level) and the four levels of Heavens (Kingdom of God – Spiritual levels) with the top level being the place where God dwells (seven levels) (I would go in it, in detail later).

It was the same reason that Jesus went to the mountaintops to prayer. If you read the Old Testament, God forbade man to worship in High places. It was considered an offense against God to worship in High places, even when they were worshiping not any idol, but the Lord Himself.

1 Kings 3

²The people, however, were still sacrificing at the high places, because a temple had not yet been built for the Name of the LORD. ³Solomon showed his love for the LORD by walking according to the statutes of his father David, except that he offered sacrifices and burned incense on the high places.

Yet in the Old Testament many of the Prophets / Men of God did worship in High places and God was not angry with them. Even in some of the Books of the Major and Minor Prophets, God called his people to come to the mountains to speak to Him and worship Him. Satan also tries to imitate the Lord and therefore also makes his worshipers, worship him in high places.

Numbers 33

⁵⁰On the plains of Moab by the Jordan across from Jericho the LORD said to Moses, ⁵¹"Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'When you cross the Jordan into Canaan, ⁵²drive out all the

inhabitants of the land before you. Destroy all their carved images and their cast idols, and demolish all their high places.

1 Kings 12

³¹ *Jeroboam built shrines on high places and appointed priests from all sorts of people, even though they were not Levites.* ³² *He instituted a festival on the fifteenth day of the eighth month, like the festival held in Judah, and offered sacrifices on the altar. This he did in Bethel, sacrificing to the calves he had made.* And at Bethel he also installed priests at the high places he had made. ³³ *On the fifteenth day of the eighth month, a month of his own choosing, he offered sacrifices on the altar he had built at Bethel. So he instituted the festival for the Israelites and went up to the altar to make offerings.*

Moses too worshiped God on the Mountaintops, but since the people were not redeemed therefore they could not come to the mountaintops to worship God. They had to go to the tabernacle to worship God.

Isaiah 36

⁷ *And if you say to me, "We are depending on the LORD our God"-isn't he the one whose high places and altars Hezekiah removed, saying to Judah and Jerusalem, "You must worship before this altar"?*

After the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross we all who believe in Christ, in His death and Resurrection, and are redeemed, we too have to go to the mountaintops to worship God. Which means to get above, disconnect from the physical world and all that it holds and go on the upper heavens (in Spirit) to worship God.

Mount Zion (Hebrew Zion and in Greek Sion) is a name used to many mountains (at least two mountains and one hill) in the Bible, for it did not refer to any specific mountain. It referred to the high grounds or Holy Mountain/s that we climb in spirit to enter God's fortress (the word Zion in Hebrew is believed to mean fortress). Even the city that David had built (City of David / Jerusalem) was called Zion.

1 Kings 8 [KJV]

¹ *Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which is Zion.*

The city of David or Jerusalem was called Zion in faith. Zion actually refers to the New Jerusalem.

Hebrews 12

²² *But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly,*

When the Lord gave me the vision to create this site, He showed me not one mountain but many mountains and many of His people were on the mountains worshiping Him. (Praise God!).

You got to keep in mind that Satan makes his people do many things that are similar to what the Lord tells us to do; only difference is that it has a little twist and makes it is against God's Word. Therefore He causes the destruction of the people by bringing the anger of God on them.

Satan too by the worldly wisdom (knowledge of good and bad) twists the truth and makes man in the physical, to climb mountains in search of God. This is seen in many of the religions where the true God is not worshiped.

Satan even at times takes things that are connected to God, twists it and makes man to do abomination against God. Like he made the Israelites do with the bronze snake on the pole.

2 Kings 18

*¹ In the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, Hezekiah son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign. ² He was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem twenty-nine years. His mother's name was Abijah daughter of Zechariah. ³ He did what was right in the eyes of the LORD, just as his father David had done. ⁴ He removed the high places, smashed the sacred stones and cut down the Asherah poles. **He broke into pieces the bronze snake Moses had made, for up to that time the Israelites had been burning incense to it. (It was called Nehushtan.)***

⁵ Hezekiah trusted in the LORD, the God of Israel. There was no one like him among all the kings of Judah, either before him or after him. ⁶ He held fast to the LORD and did not cease to follow him; he kept the commands the LORD had given Moses.

There are things that Satan even today, makes many of us Christians to do that are against God's Word. As I came to know, I was shocked like John was in the book of Revelations, how Satan is manipulating the churches (both the Catholic and Protestant churches). You might find it hard to take, but as the Lord opens you spiritual eyes; you will see what I am saying.

Now coming back to the angels, the Word of God says the angels are always in the presence of God and have their faces, faced towards the Glory of God admiring it at all times.

Matthew 18

¹⁰ "See that you do not look down on one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven

Luke 1

¹⁹ The angel answered, "I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news.

In hierarchy the angels come under the cherubim's. The cherubim are the beasts that are present around God's throne.

Revelation 4

¹ After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." ² At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it. ³ And the one who sat there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian. A rainbow, resembling an emerald, encircled the throne.

⁶Also before the throne there was what looked like a sea of glass, clear as crystal.

In the center, around the throne, were four living creatures, and they were covered with eyes, in front and in back. ⁷The first living creature was like a lion, the second was like an ox, the third had a face like a man, the fourth was like a flying eagle. ⁸Each of the four living creatures had six wings and was covered with eyes all around, even under his wings. Day and night they never stop saying: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come." ⁹Whenever the living creatures give glory, honor and thanks to him who sits on the throne and who lives for ever and ever, ¹⁰the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne, and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say:

¹¹"You are worthy, our Lord and God,
to receive glory and honor and power,
for you created all things,
and by your will they were created
and have their being."

Before I go much into the details of the cherubim, I would like to cover about angels in brief. Like I was saying; after the Lord come the cherubim, then the angels and then other spirit beings and last man.

Luke 2

¹³*Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying,*

This order will change and we humans will be put above the angels after the day of the Lord. Therefore Paul in his letter to the church in Corinth wrote:-

1 Corinthians 6

²*Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases? ³Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more the things of this life!*

This happens only due to Jesus Christ. Since Jesus Christ (Son of Man) was called by God to sit at His right hand and we, who are called as brothers and sisters of Christ, and are the body of Christ, we will become one with Him and also be seated at the right (righteous) hand of the Father.

Hebrews 1

⁵*For to which of the angels did God ever say,
"You are my Son;
today I have become your Father"? Or again,
"I will be his Father,
and he will be my Son"? ⁶And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says,
"Let all God's angels worship him." ⁷In speaking of the angels he says,
"He makes his angels winds,
his servants flames of fire." ⁸But about the Son he says,
"Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever,
and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom.*

Hebrews 2

⁵*It is not to angels that he has subjected the world to come, about which we are speaking.* ⁶*But there is a place where someone has testified:*

*"What is man that you are mindful of him,
the son of man that you care for him?*

⁷*You made him a little lower than the angels;
you crowned him with glory and honor*

⁸*and put everything under his feet? In putting everything under him, God left nothing that is not subject to him. Yet at present we do not see everything subject to him.*

God has made angels to execute His commands and to serve us.

1 Corinthians 10

⁹*We should not test the Lord, as some of them did—and were killed by snakes.* ¹⁰*And do not grumble, as some of them did—and were killed by the destroying angel.*

When the face of God is on a person (or God is pleased with a person) an angel/s is made charge over him/her. The angel protects and looks after that person at all times.

Hebrews 1

¹³*To which of the angels did God ever say,*

*"Sit at my right hand
until I make your enemies*

*a footstool for your feet"? ¹⁴*Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?**

1 Peter 1

¹²*It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves but you, when they spoke of the things that have now been told you by those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven. Even angels long to look into these things.*

Psalm 91

¹*He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High
will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.*

¹¹*For he will command his angels concerning you
to guard you in all your ways;*

¹²*they will lift you up in their hands,
so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.*

Angels do not have an age (many of the images have angels as small babes with wings; they look cute but are just imaginary).

Luke 20

³⁵*But those who are considered worthy of taking part in that age and in the resurrection from the dead will neither marry nor be given in marriage,* ³⁶*and they can no longer die; for they are like the angels.*

There are also different hierarchies among angels.

1 Timothy 5

²¹I charge you, in the sight of God and Christ Jesus and the elect angels, to keep these instructions without partiality, and to do nothing out of favoritism.

1 Thessalonians 4

¹⁶For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

There are different groups or armies of angels (legions all together seven) that are overlooked by an Archangel and by the Cherubim's and over all by the Lord.

God has angels for different purposes, some to protect, some to destroy, some to delivery, some that just travel around to get information (not for God, for He knows all) etc...

Angels are not to be worshiped for they too are fellow being like us under the Lord.

Colossians 2

¹⁸Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. ¹⁹He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.

Revelation 22

⁸I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I had heard and seen them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who had been showing them to me. ⁹But he said to me, "Do not do it! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers the prophets and of all who keep the words of this book. Worship God!"

In fact we should not worship any being living or dead other than God.
